

Prior to accepting the position at the MCPA in February of 2021, Jeff was the Chief of Police for the Bloomington Police Department for the preceding 12 years.

Jeff holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Concordia College, and a Master of Arts Degree in Police Administration from the University of St. Thomas. He is also a graduate of the FBI's National Academy in Quantico, Virginia.

He began his career as a patrol officer in 1991. During his career with the Bloomington Police Department, he served in various positions including Officer, Sergeant and Commander of various divisions within the police department before being appointed to the position of Police Chief. Throughout Jeff's law enforcement career, he has served on various Boards, to include the Bloomington Chamber of Commerce (Ex-Officio), Hennepin County Chiefs of Police Association as well as at the Minnesota Chiefs of Police Association (MCPA) including being the Association's President from 2019-2020. Jeff has been very involved in the recent police reform legislation on behalf of the MCPA.
