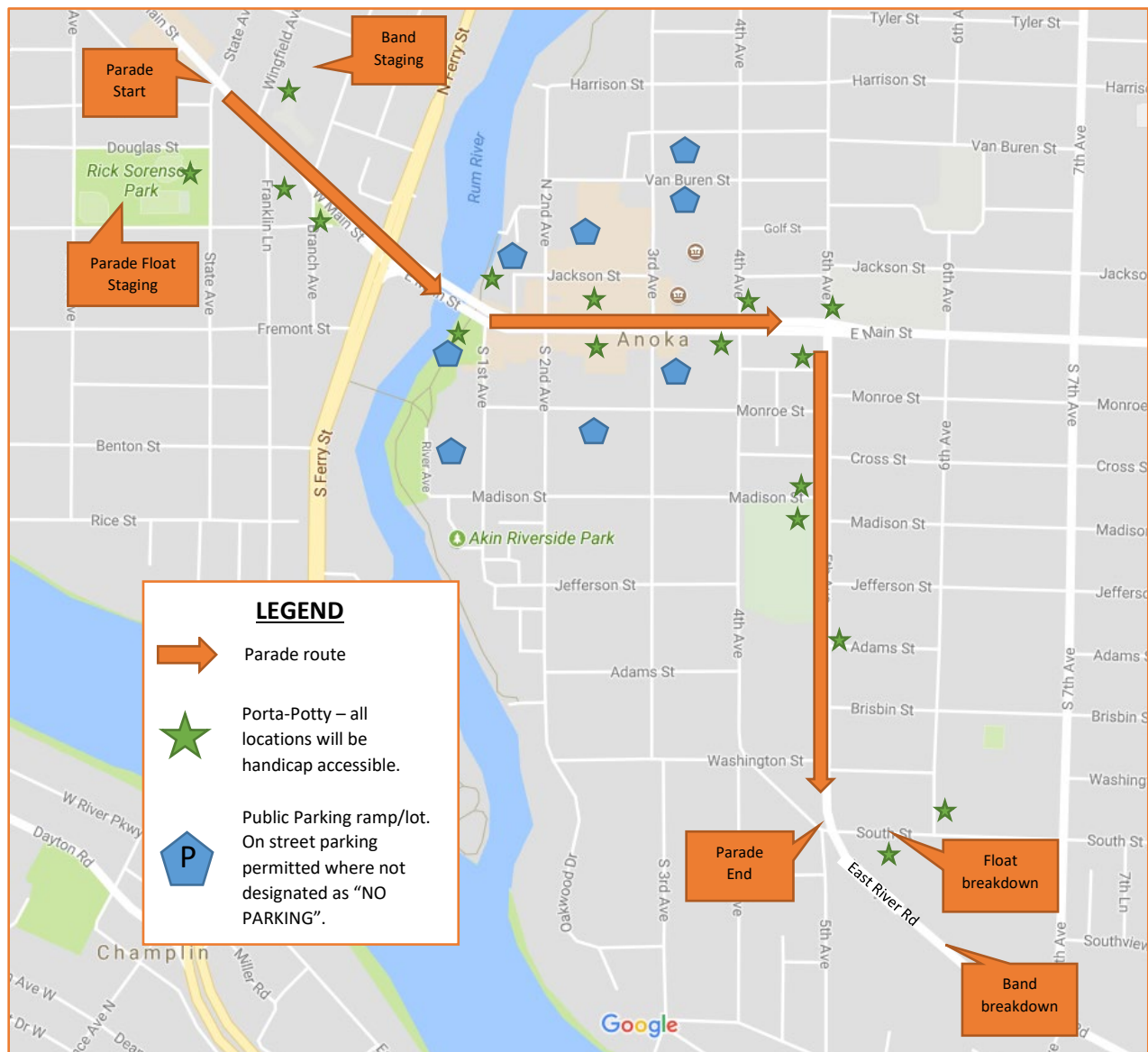


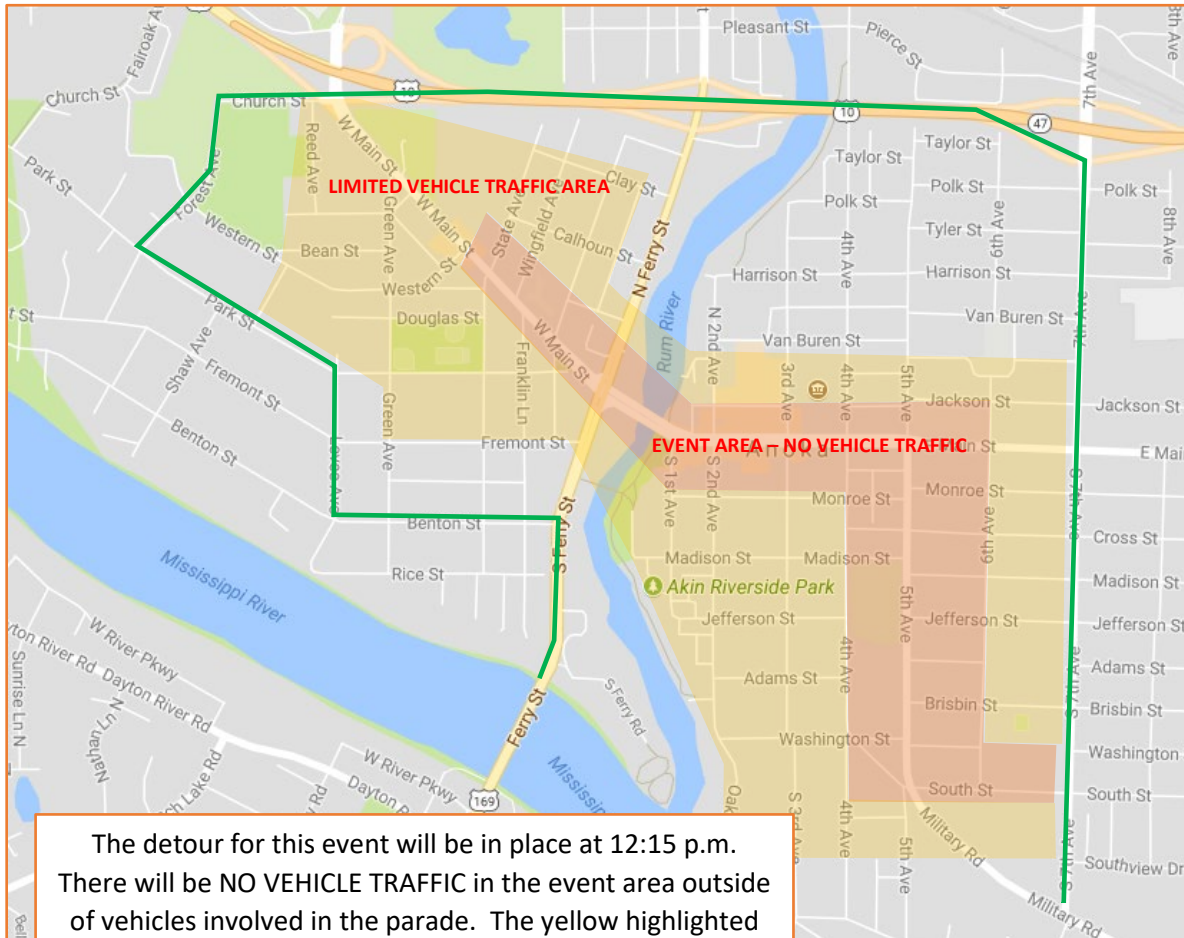

Halloween Grande Parade Detour Route

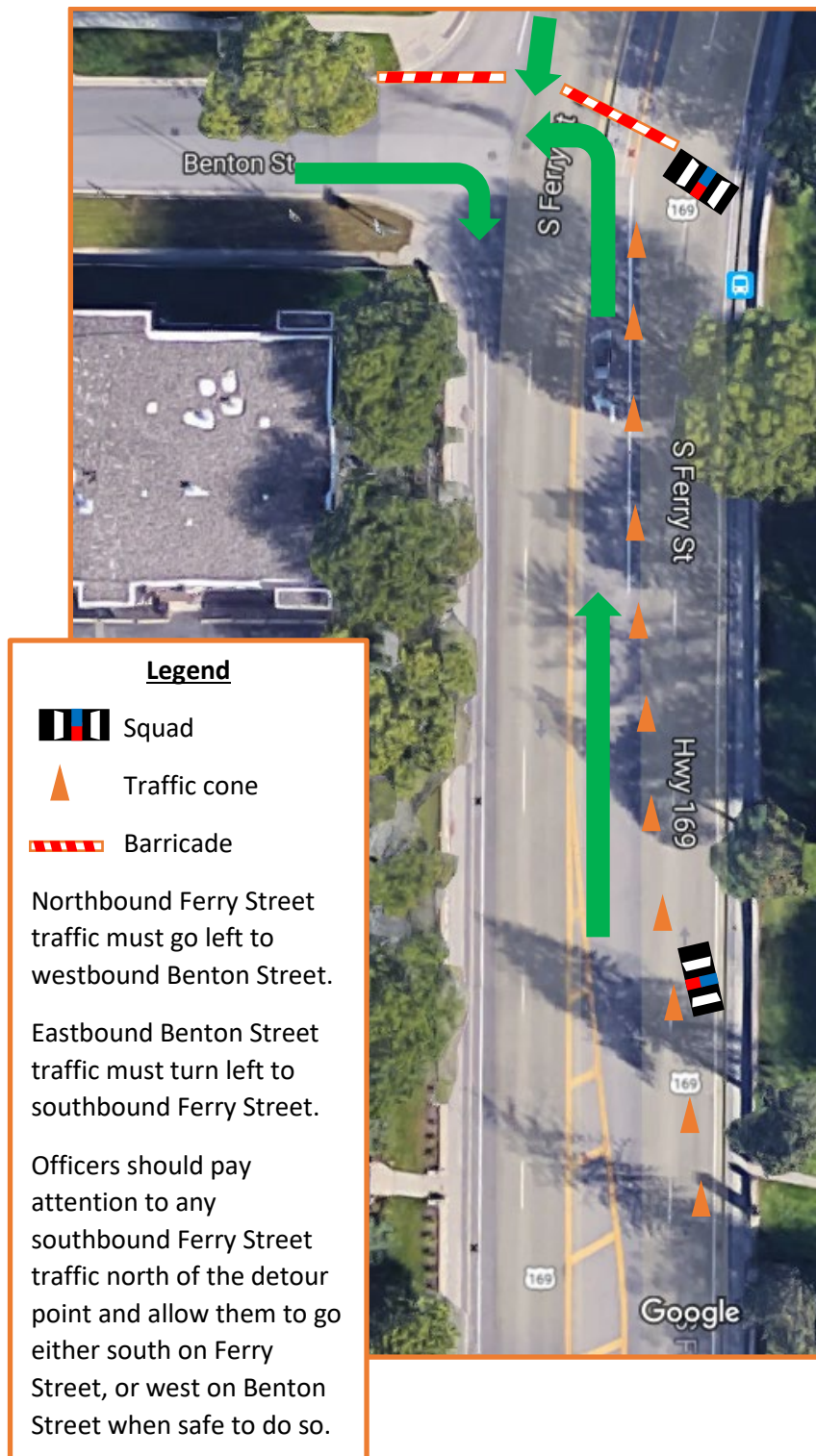

The yellow highlighted area will have limited vehicle traffic. Officers will be directing traffic at roads and intersections that are closed for this event.

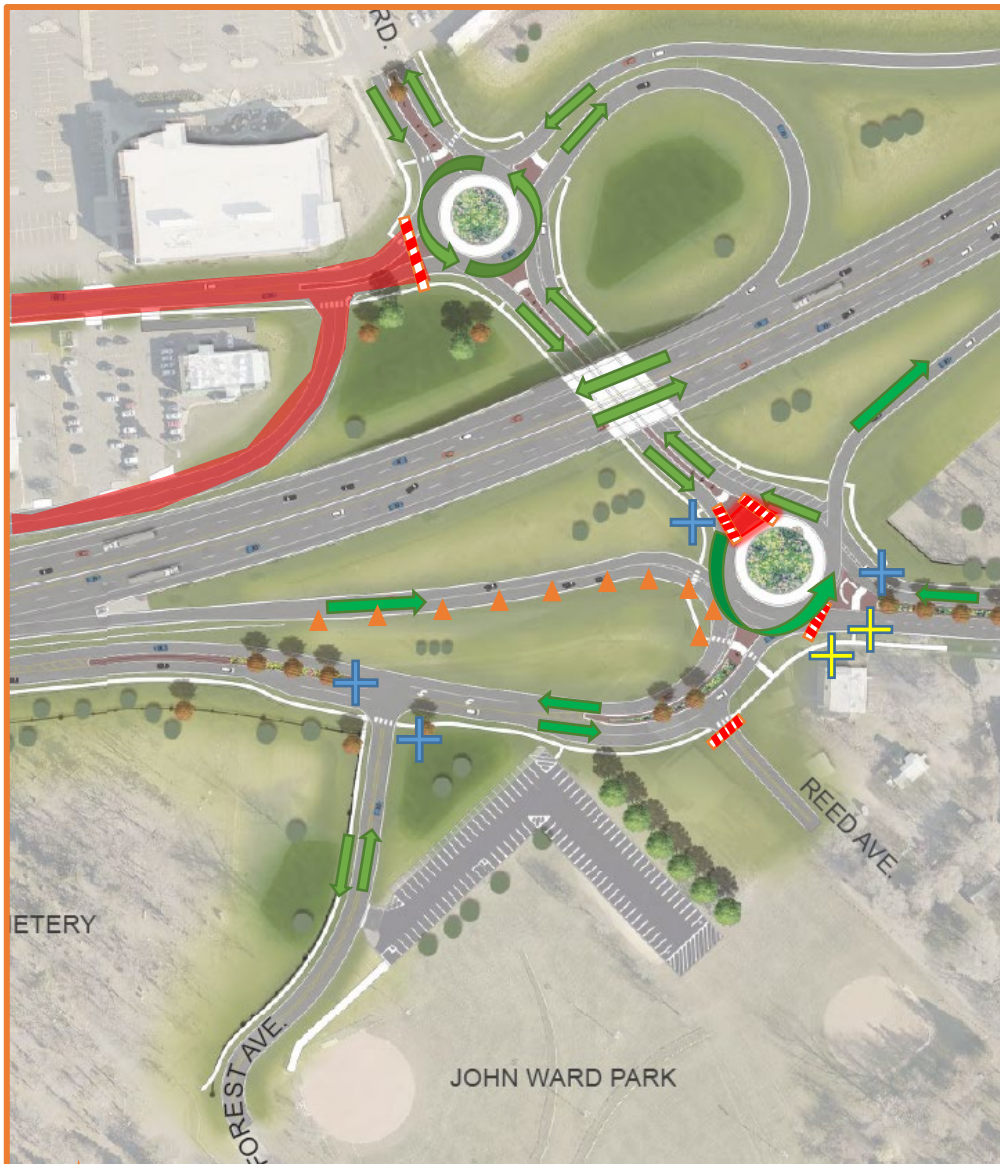
Halloween Grande Parade Gray Ghost Run/Walk

Halloween Grande Parade W. Main Street & Church Street Detour

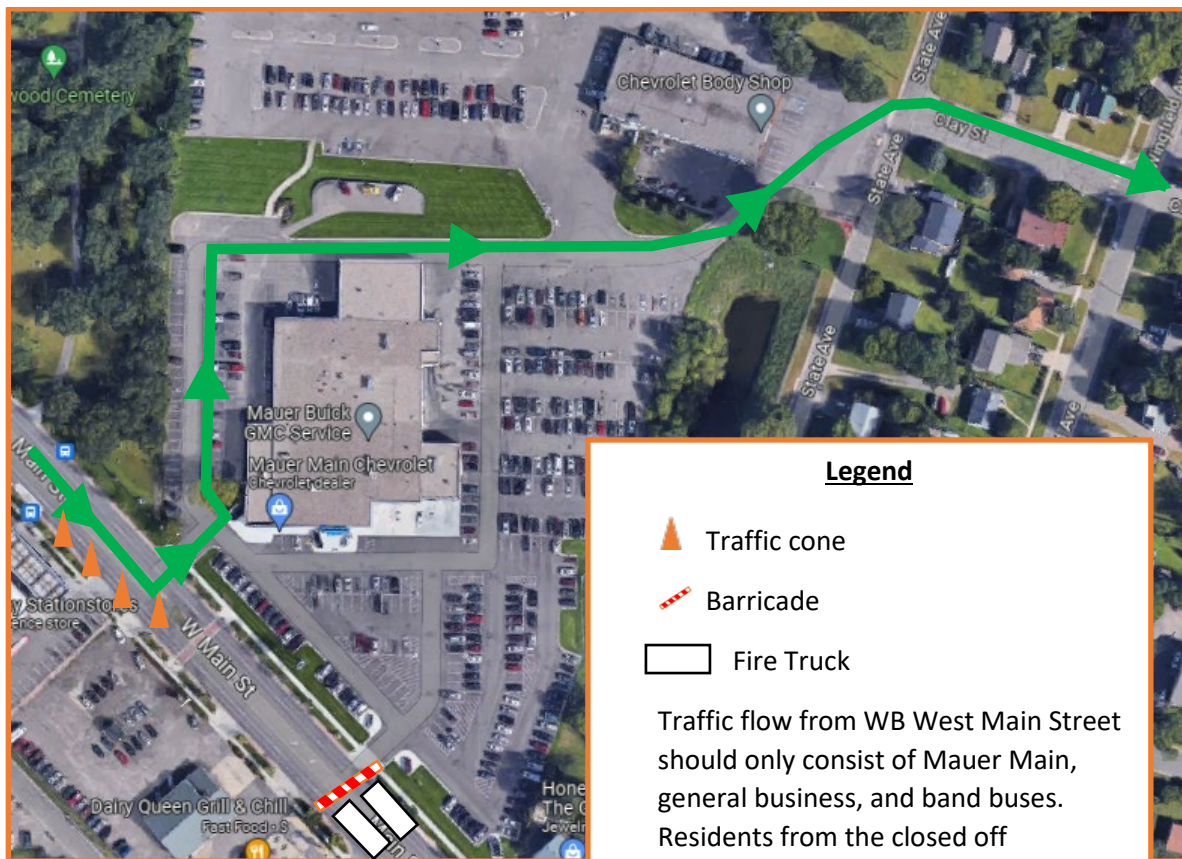

Officers at this detour assignment will have several lanes of traffic to monitor and direct. Traffic cones will be used to reduce 2 lane roadways to 1 lane. Keep traffic flowing and listen for updates from the detour Supervisor on how to best keep traffic moving. The only traffic allowed on West Main Street should be Mauer Main, general business, and band buses – being limited to 6 bands this year. + Officers will have to vet who to allow EB West Main Street.

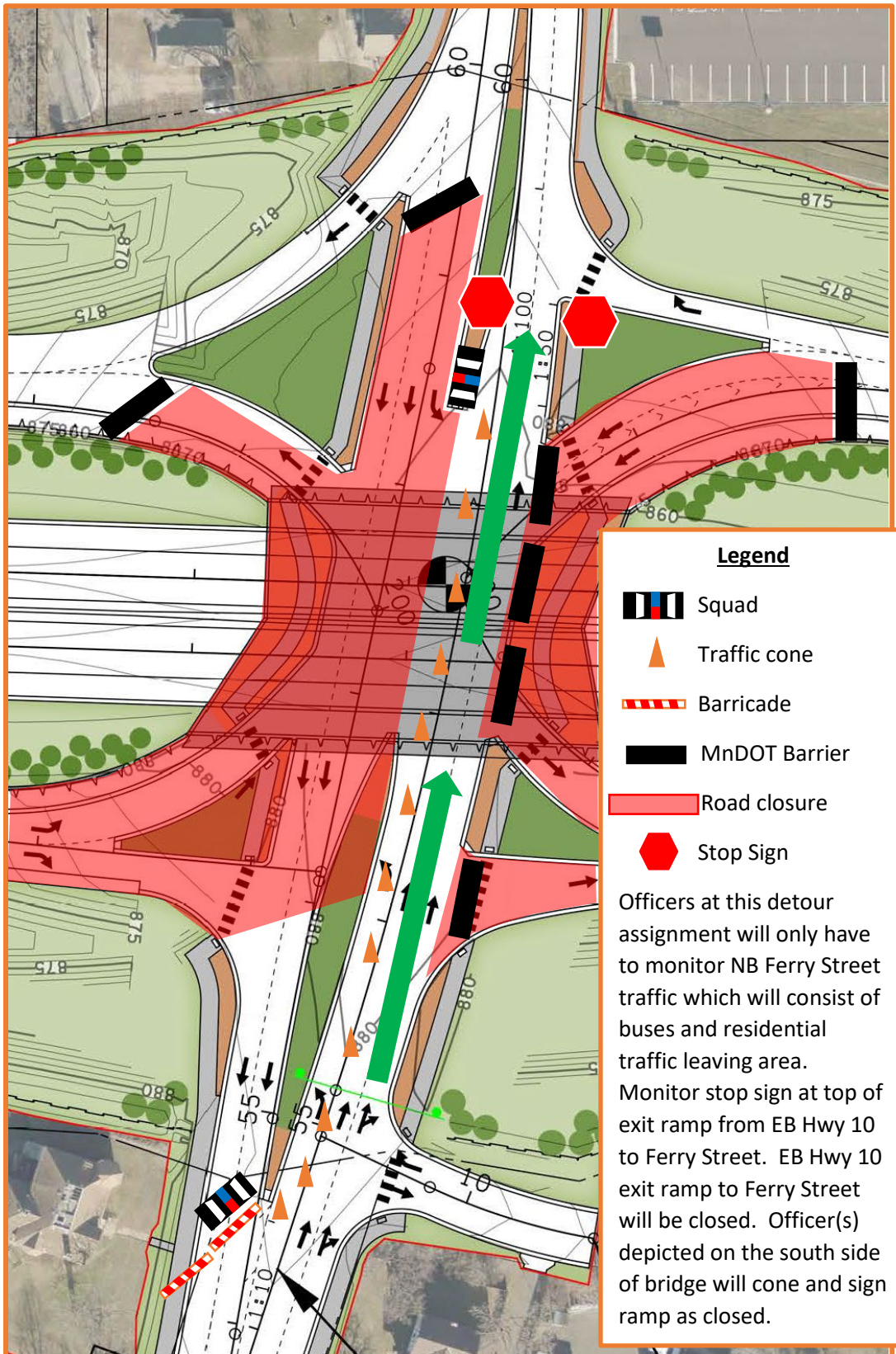
▲ Traffic cone

Traffic flow from WB West Main Street should only consist of Mauer Main, general business, and band buses. Residents from the closed off neighborhood to the east of Mauer and band buses will be direct as depicted. Fire trucks will be positioned to be a hard barrier to the start of the parade.
